

Duties of Chief Petty Officers and Petty Officers - (1934)

The following are extracts from the Queen's Regulations and Admiralty Orders:-

Article 1850, Clause 4

It is the duty of every chief petty officer, petty officer, non commissioned officer, or leading rating, to keep himself informed of any cause of complaint or dissatisfaction among the men, and to inform his Divisional Officer so that the matter may be investigated.

Article 1853, Clause 3

It is the duty of every chief petty officer and petty officer (or equivalent rating) of all branches of the Service to ensure that order and regularity are preserved in his vicinity among those men, of whatever branch and whether on duty or not, who hold a rank or rating junior to him.
